

COVID-19 Protocols



These protocols are in effect beginning September 22, 2021 and are subject to change prior to the retreat beginning on March 31, 2022. When you register for the retreat, you are agreeing to abide by the COVID protocols in effect as of March 31, 2022. Also, retreat registration fees are non-refundable but are transferable to another attendee. Registration fees paid for the 2022 event may not be applied to future events.

TCC's Commitment to Covid Safety Protocols

All attendees are required to submit documentation regarding COVID vaccination and will wear masks for all internal activities. In addition, TCC will follow all recommended protocols according to the CDC as well as any additional State of Texas requirements and those from T Bar M.
