What are the dates for the event?

March 31 - April 3, 2022

When is the deadline for presenter applications?

October 31, 2021

What is the topic?

The All Texas Retreat and Conference theme is based on the tagline of the Texas Coaches Coalition: "Connecting, Supporting, and Inspiring." All applications should be relevant to this theme from a coaching perspective.

What are the presenting opportunities?

There are three presentation opportunities that presenters can choose from. Morning and afternoon activities do not require ICF certification.

1. Plenary presentations. These 45-minute presentations will be to the whole group, in the form of a keynote speech. These sessions will be recorded by audio for public distribution.
2. Breakout sessions. These 90-minute workshops will be interactive and focus on either core coaching competencies or resource development items. These sessions will be recorded by audio for public distribution.
3. Morning Activities. These up to one-hour sessions will take place before breakfast. We are looking for creative activities such as group journaling, hiking, mindfulness meditations, Tai Chi, etc.
4. Afternoon Activities. These up to one-hour sessions will take place before dinner, with an emphasis on creative outlets.

How will applications be evaluated?

The review committee will have an evaluation rubric to assist with evaluating applications. The rubric will consider the following criteria:

- ICF credentials of the lead presenter for plenary and breakout sessions are preferred.
- Co-presenters do not necessarily need to be ICF certified. However, solo presenters or those leading a presentation must be so.
- CCE potential. All presentations will be judged according to their potential to be approved by the ICF for continuing coach education credit.
- Core Competencies vs. Resource Development. Priority will be given to core competency presentations, as these CCE's are typically the most difficult for coaches to obtain.

Why are you requiring this specific information?

The information required will be used for five purposes:

- for evaluation by the committee as a potential speaker,
- to apply for Coach Continuing Education credit with the ICF,
- to promote the event,
- to inform attendees about your presentation,
- to populate a database for when other ICF chapters need presenters.

What information is required with the application?

Before completing the form, be sure to have the following information ready:

- Name and contact information
- Status of current ICF credential and when it will be renewed
- A professional bio
- A digital photo (for publicity purposes)
- A list of learning outcomes
- A summary of the content
- A description of how you will keep the content interactive
- Permission to record your presentation for public distribution

What if I have handouts or other materials that I need?

Presenters are responsible for their handouts, supplies, or similar materials. A screen, a projector, a flipchart, microphone, and pens will be available.

Must I have an email address to submit my application?

Yes.

Must I submit my application online?

Yes.

How will I know that my application has been submitted successfully?

You will receive confirmation that your application is completed.

When will I be notified of the committee's decision?

All presenters will be notified by November 30, 2021.
